"Sit and See" is a gripping first person story, told with a bitter irony, it will not leave you indifferent if you watch the news today. The story succeeds in describing a human catastrophe simply and without pretentiousness. The title refers to the historically important film "Come and See" by Elem Klimov about the Nazis' atrocities towards the Belarusians. A large family - the main character Marta Kaidanovskaya, her sister Tonya, father, mother, grandfather, and grandmother flee the terrible sounds in their apartment, drive (or rather, get stuck in traffic jams) in a cramped car towards the Rubi-Cone border, where the bombs are rumbling.

Along the way, they have many adventures. At some point, they stop at a motel, reminiscent of the Zone in the movie "Stalker", where Marta meets a writer, Andrey Bulbenko, and hands him two mysterious envelopes. The first contains fourteen scattered sheets, written in small handwriting on the back are some instructions...







Author's note:

This book was inspired by my many journeys through Siberia and the Russian Far East. The people I met there often told me fascinating stories about otherworldly creatures - fantastical in both their looks and their actions.

After a while, when I got to know them well enough, the strange inhabitants of North Asia began showing up before me. I saw them everywhere: on trains and planes, at coffee shops and gas stations, in the mountains, forests, dark damp caves, and even inside my bottomless, heavy hiking backpack.

Through summer heat and winter snow I pursued their faintest traces. Earth and water, dreams and memories crystallised in the frigid northern air - I went through it all in my search.

Others found me on their own. They followed me everywhere, falling into my pockets and boots, cosying up inside my beanie or atop my glove to tell me, again and again: "Please, write about me... Will you do it? Did you already? Why not? You have to do it! The world needs to know about me. It needs to know me."

That being said, I've never met most of the creatures I write about in this book, thankfully. I draw their descriptions from the works of scientists, amateur explorers, shamans, travellers, and locals. Of course, many of their accounts are exaggerated, but we have no other choice than to take their word for it.
